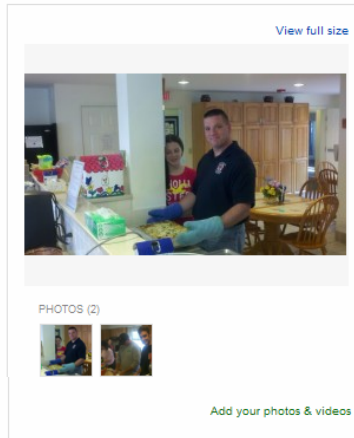
Members of the North Kingstown Firefighters Association (NKFFA) have vowed to help at the Providence Ronald McDonald House by providing meals for families staying at the house throughout the year.







As part of a statewide campaign by the Rhode Island Association of Firefighters, the NKFFA was the second fire department in the state to prepare and serve dinner for families staying at the Ronald McDonald House on Monday, Apr. 25. Based solely upon NKFFA funds, members, retirees, and their families were able to feed approximately 30 people staying at the house, while their ailing children are receiving treatment in nearby hospitals. Additionally, family members of the firefighters helped make cards for the hospitalized children and played with siblings staying at the house while the meal was being prepared.

The Ronald McDonald house is always in need of volunteers, and the members of the NKFFA have vowed to do their part and continue to help in the future.
