A tab at a time

mately 240 pounds of aluminum can pop tabs, or about \$300 worth, to the Ronald McDonald House in Providence. This facility uses the money generated from recycling the tabs to feed families who stay temporarily — at little to no cost — while an ill family member is treated at a nearby health center. With the help of family, friends, and many others, as
